Hotel Information

All program activities and the ASA Exhibits, Registration, Bookstore, and Employment Service will be located at the *Palais des congrès de Montréal*, the convention center in downtown Montréal. The ASA Child Care Service will be located at the Delta Centre-ville, the designated headquarters hotel two blocks from the Palais. Room blocks at ASA convention rates are available at the Delta Centre-ville and five other downtown hotels, and ASA will provide shuttle service between those hotels (*starred below) and the convention centre.

Please note that room rates are given in Canadian dollars and exclude all service charges and government taxes (currently 3% occupancy tax, 7.0% GST, and 7.5% PST).

1. Delta Centre-ville* (on University)

Single: \$189 Double: \$189

The Delta Centre-Ville is located in the heart of downtown, at the crossroads of Old Montréal and the new business district, Le Quartier international. Close by are the Palais des congrès (convention centre), the Bell Centre, and the Casino. The hotel is just steps away from museums, trendy restaurants, and city festivals and attractions. The métro (subway) and underground city can be accessed from the hotel. Delta guest rooms are spacious, with large panoramic windows for great views of Downtown and Old Montreal; amenities include coffee makers with complimentary coffee, and access to the health club.

2. Fairmont The Queen Elizabeth*

This grand and gracious hotel treats guests to non-smoking floors, private floors with concierge services, a health centre and indoor pool. Each room is equipped with two telephones and high-speed Internet. The hotel is home to three restaurants, including the famous CAA/AAA four-diamond Beaver Club and connects directly to the boutiques of the city's 30-km-long underground pedestrian network. Guests can also take advantage of its business centre, catering service, tea room, and the Beaver Club's gourmet boutique. ASA meeting attendees who book their rooms through the official housing service will have complimentary use of the health club.

3. Hôtel InterContinental Montréal*

Centrally located in the heart of the Quartier international, between Old Montréal and downtown, the Hôtel InterContinental Montréal is within convenient walking distance of the city's most notable business and leisure attractions, finest shopping and entertainment. The hotel offers its guests a world of total comfort in its richly appointed guest rooms and luxurious suites, fine dining in its renowned restaurant, Les Continents, or a light meal and drink at its piano-bar, Le Cristallin, or its bistro, Chez Plume. The hotel faces the Palais des congrès (convention centre) and links directly to the underground pedestrian network.

4. Hyatt Regency Montréal*

Single: \$179 Double: \$179

The Hyatt Regency Montréal has invested close to \$20 million in renovations to its rooms, suites, restaurant, and bar to offer its guests impeccable style and comfort. The new Regency Club with private salon and terrace has also been added to provide unparalleled service. You can access the hotel by its main lobby as well as by the underground city, which connects you to the métro (subway), the Palais des congrès, the complexe Desjardins, the Place des Arts, and the Musée d'art contemporain.

5. Le Centre Sheraton*

Single: \$199 Double: \$199

Located in the heart of downtown, steps away from all major attractions, the hotel offers elegantly appointed guest rooms and suites featuring a wide range of commodities, such as the Sweet Sleeper bed. Its health centre comes complete with an indoor pool, whirlpool, sauna, and fitness room. Discover its restaurant Bistro Le Boulevard and Le Café Bar. ASA meeting attendees who book their rooms through the official housing service will earn Double Starwood Preferred points on their reservations.

6. Montréal Marriott Château Champlain*

This world-class landmark hotel is in the heart of downtown Montréal, adjacent to the Bell Centre, and directly connected to the underground city, métro (subway), and train station. 7. McGill University, New Residence Hall (for students only)
