Deadline: Preregistration closes on July 11. Forms and payments must be postmarked/faxed no later than July 11 to be eligible for the preregistration discount. Registration materials postmarked/faxed after July 11 will not be accepted for preregistration; they will held at the Situations Desk in Montreal for processing at the on-site registration rates shown above.

Program Participants: All program participants are required to preregister by May 31 in order to have their names listed in the Final Program. Program participant registration fees are non-refundable. Only one registration fee payment is required from a participant. If additional payments are received, 90% of duplicate fees will be refunded.

Program participants who have already paid for registration may add events and services to their general registration by checking off the appropriate items and remitting the appropriate fee payment.
