## 2006 Student Travel Award Application

### General Information

The Student Forum of the American Sociological Association (ASA) administers student travel awards to the ASA Annual Meeting. We anticipate granting approximately 25 awards in the amount of \$200 each. These awards are made on a competitive basis and are meant to assist students by defraying costs associated with attending the Annual Meeting. All applicants are encouraged to seek additional sources of funding to attend the Annual Meeting.

All applications must be typed or neatly printed. Four (4) copies of the completed application must be submitted no later than May 1, 2006. Decisions will be announced no later than June 15, 2006. Only applications from individuals on their own behalf will be accepted.

### Eligibility

Applicants must be students pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in an academic institution and a current student member of ASA (at the time of application). Participation in the Annual Meeting (e.g., paper sessions, roundtables), purpose for attending (e.g., workshop training, Honors Program participation), and the potential benefit to the student are among the factors taken into account in making awards.

Awardees will be selected by a travel award committee of the Student Forum convened especially for this purpose.
